- 3. Poem 90 Sec Flipgrid Video, memorized (highly suggested), any type (lyric, narrative, free verse, sonnet, etc.) If your video is not through Flipgrid (groups), you must submit sharable link on TEAMS.
- 4. Dramatic presentation.
- 5. Represents theme: No Place for Hate: Diversity, Friendship, Acceptance, Tolerance (...at a Distance)
- 6. No inappropriate language.
- 7. Teachers must approve video before it will be viewable. You may be asked to submit script.
- 8. All poems due by 4:00pm May 13. Submit on Flipgrid. (Please plan ahead.)
- 9. Around 20 finalists will be included in the compilation video.
- 10. May 14-- Judging
- 11. May 15 Poetry Slam Watch Party (Time TBD)
